 1. **Emergency Shelter** (*Amy's House*)
 2. **24/7 Crisis Hotline (704-736-1224)**
 3. Referrals for emergency and medical treatment
 4. **Legal and court advocacy** (protective orders, custody decisions and child support)
 5. Interpretation services
 6. Legal aid referrals
 7. Counselling referrals
 8. Child advocacy referrals
 9. **Case Management** for in-shelter survivors
 10. **Program Management** for out-of-shelter survivors
 11. **Safety Planning** and assessment
 12. **Goal setting** for the future
 13. **Support groups** - peer support, signs and symptoms of abuse, bolstering self-esteem
 14. **Financial planning** - budgeting, checking accounts, etc.
 15. **Job skills & Placement** - interviewing skills, applications, resumes, dressing for success
 16. Assistance in finding affordable, **safe housing**
